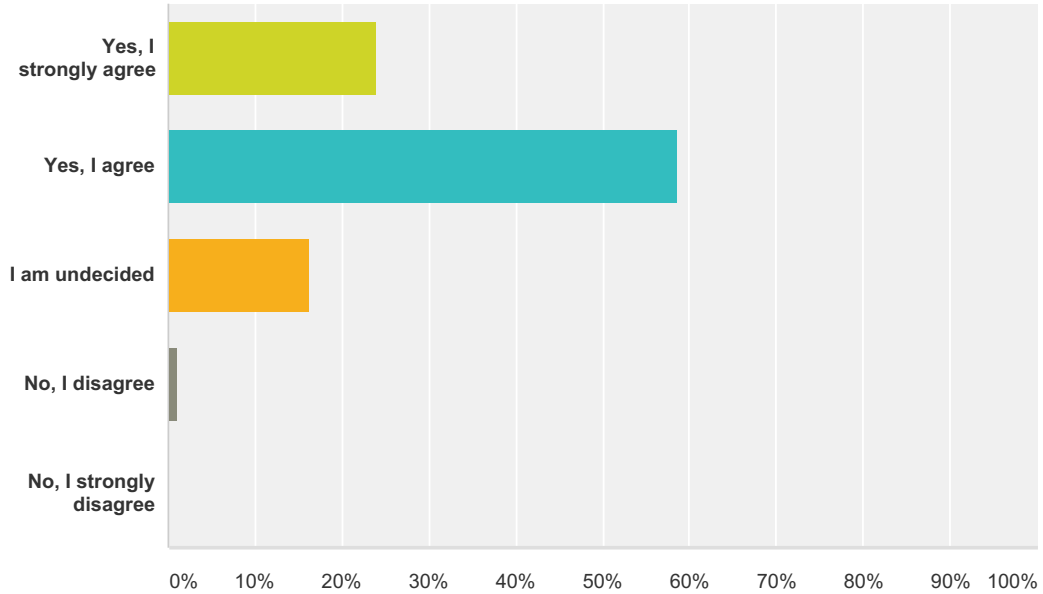


ATS Membership Survey

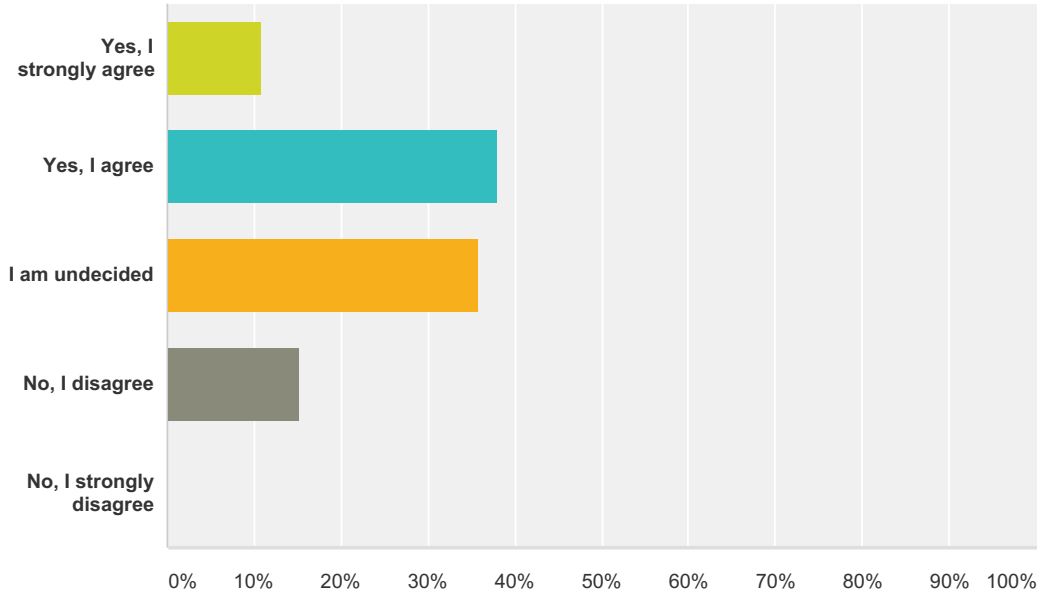

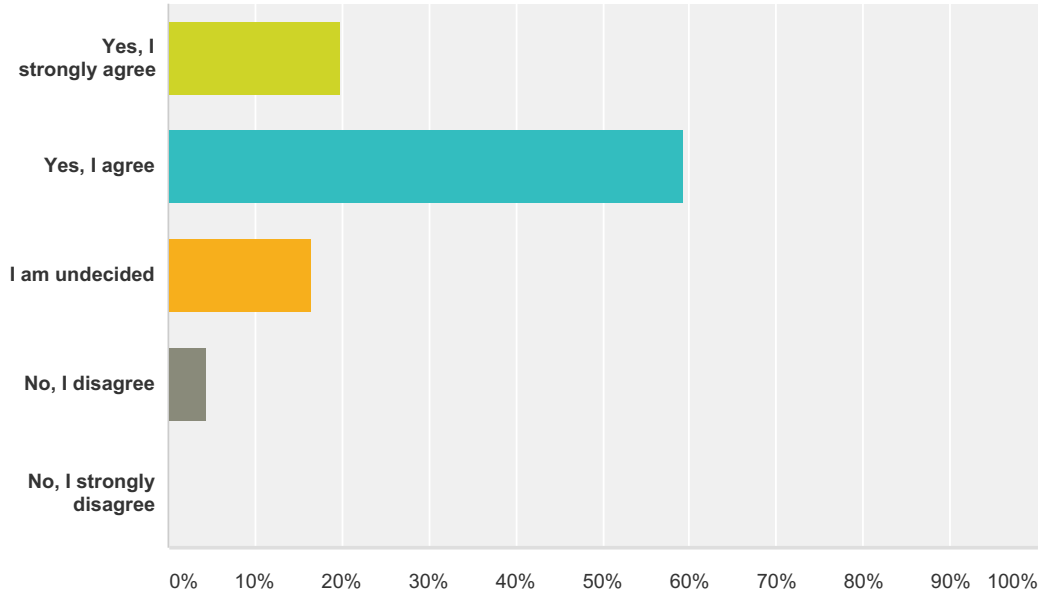

Q3 The academy should more proactively facilitate access of institutions to the services of ATS Fellows – e.g., by specifying on our website a point of contact (our Executive Director).

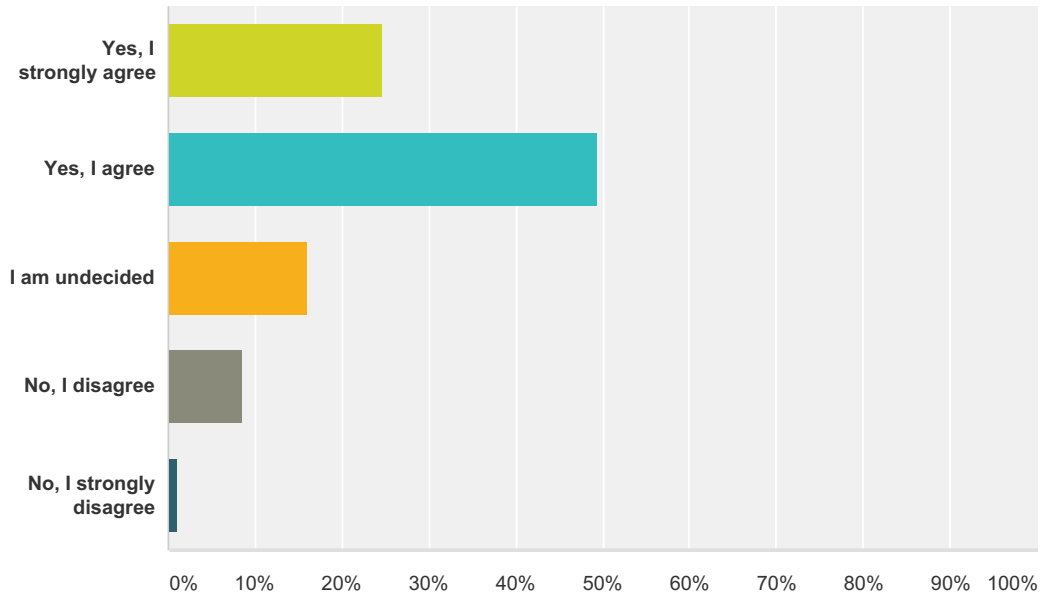

Q4 The academy should more actively provide information about the specific expertise of our Fellows in diverse areas of the toxicological sciences.

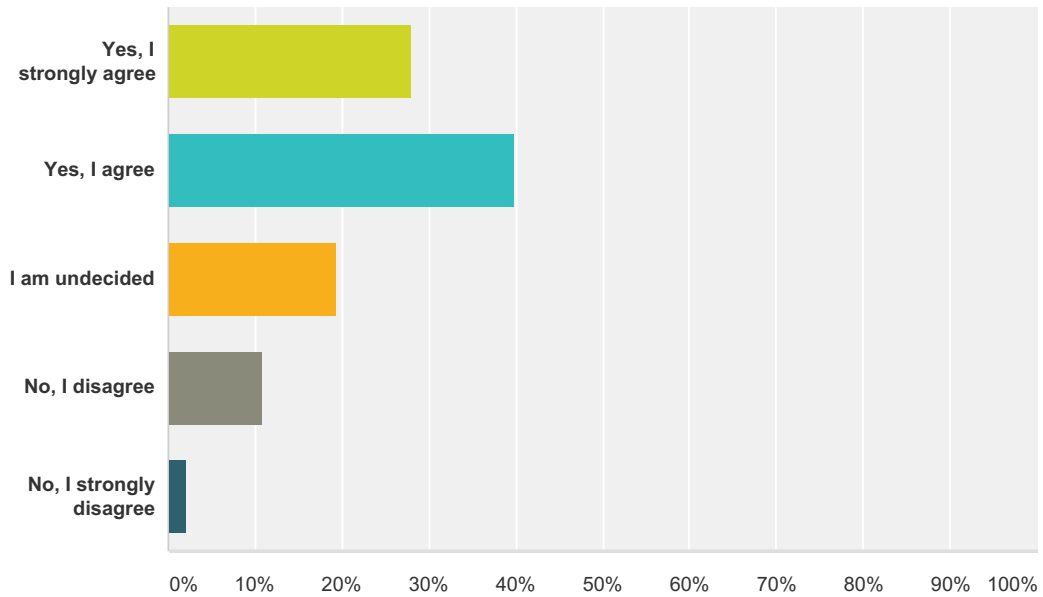

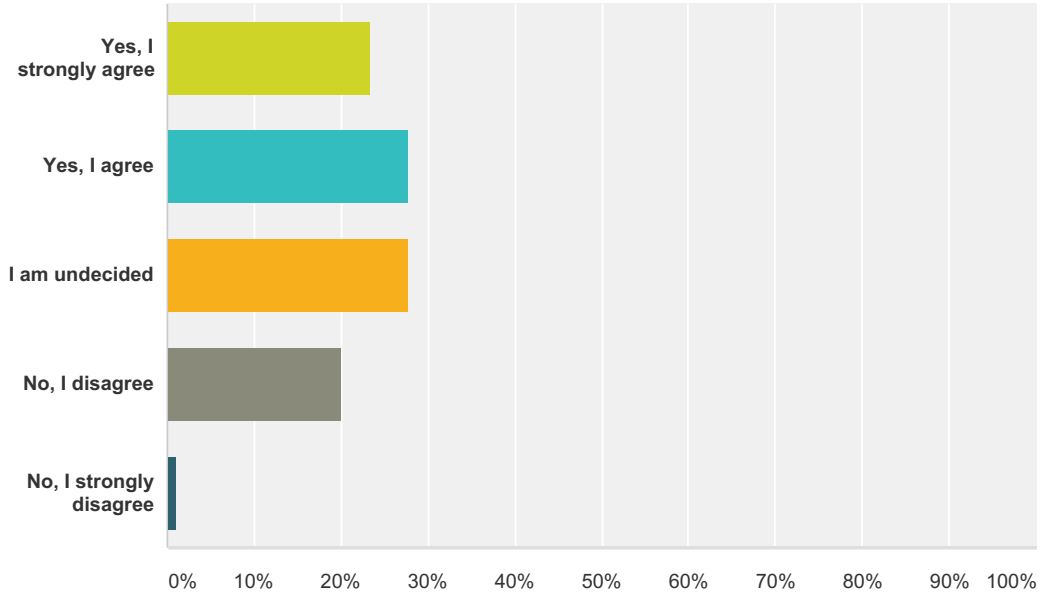

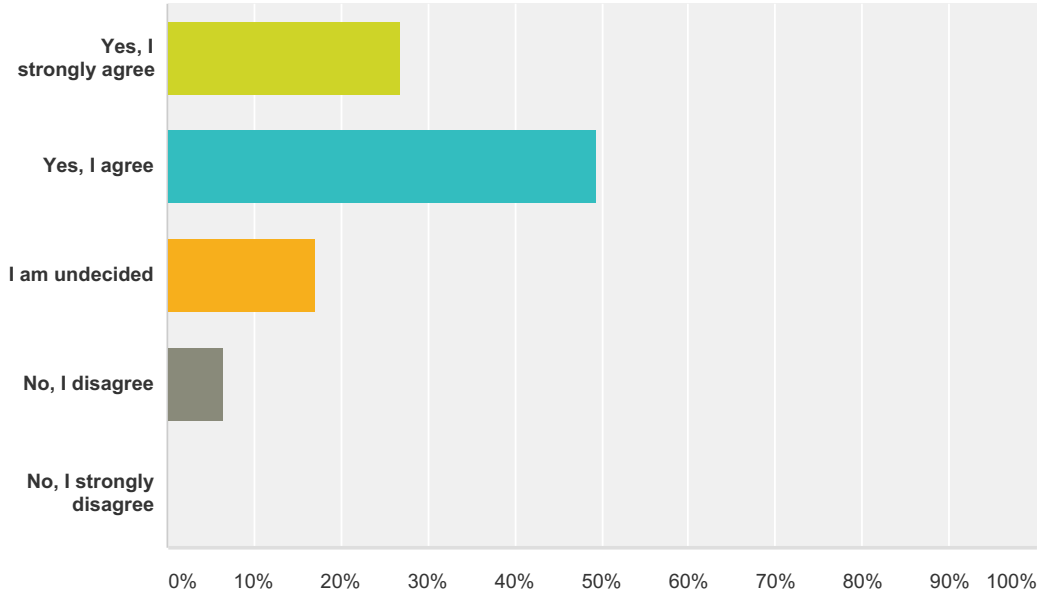
